Dear Administrator Neffenger,

I write today to express serious concerns regarding reports of racial profiling of Somali-Americans by the Transportation Security Administration's (TSA) Minneapolis-St. Paul regional office. The report alleges that an assistant security director was instructed to provide the names of Somali-American leaders visiting the TSA office so that those names could be referenced against national security databases for terrorist ties.

Minnesota is home to the nation's largest Somali-American population—a vibrant community that I'm proud to represent in the Senate. As you know, racial and ethnic profiling undermines trust in the authorities and causes resentment among targeted groups. I therefore request that you immediately open an investigation into these reports.

Thank you for your attention to this important matter, and I look forward to working with you to address it as quickly as possible.
